Important Notes

1. Recurring scholarship applications will be accepted no later than the fourth Sunday in June. Recurring scholarship applicants must:
 - a. Remain an active TNMBC member in good standing.
 - b. Maintain cumulative 2.5 GPA.
 - i. If a student fails to maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA, they will not receive funds for the upcoming semester. However, if they meet the cumulative 2.5 GPA requirement during the semester for which their funds were not awarded, they can receive funds for the next semester (if they meet other eligibility requirements). The money forfeited for the semester where the GPA was less than 2.5 cannot be reinstated. Students must continue to maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA to retain eligibility to receive scholarship awards.
 - c. Submit applications for recurring scholarships to the Scholarship Ministry for each recurring year by the last Sunday in June, at 11:00am.
 - d. Submit a 750-word essay, with recurring application, on one of the following topics:
 - i. How has college impacted my life this year?
 - ii. Personal Statement: How my witness has impacted my post-secondary environment.
 - iii. "A Divine Push" - Describe two things during this academic year that have acted as a divine push for you to continue to pursue your educational goals.
 - iv. Why should loving God and obeying His word be a priority as you pursue your educational and career goals?
 - v. How do you plan to use your post-secondary education to bless others?
 - vi. How will God's word empower you to extend your witness to others on your college/university campus?
 - e. Submit an unofficial college transcript with their recurring application (recurring scholarship applicants may be required to submit an official transcript at any time during the academic year).
 - f. Participate in ministry activities as prescribed by the Scholarship Ministry and approved by the Senior Pastor. Alternatively, provide a confirmation letter, signed by a ministry official, detailing participation in church or campus ministry activities with recurring application.
 - g. Submit fall semester invoices and transcript (for the previous semester) to Scholarship Ministry Leader by the first Friday in August, or when available from the school.
 - h. Submit spring semester invoices and transcript (for the previous semester) to the Scholarship Ministry Leader by the third Friday in December, or when available from the school.
2. TNMBC will not disburse scholarship payment for invoices submitted with zero or credit balances.
3. TNMBC scholarships must be used to pay tuition, room and board, books, and required fees.
 - a. Payment for books – to receive payment for books, applicant must submit class schedule, required book list and proof of book costs.
4. TNMBC will not pay for the cost of school supplies.
5. TNMBC will not reimburse parents/students for payments.
6. Total amount of disbursements (for fall and spring semesters) must not exceed the total annual award.
7. Any exceptions to the guidelines must be granted by the Senior Pastor.
